## DOUBLE DEGREES IN LAW:

### The advantages of double degrees in Law

In addition to the French law degree, students obtain a degree from the partner university. Double degrees validate students' legal skills in two different legal systems and enable them to apply for Master's, LL.M or postgraduate programmes internationally. Students can also access vocational training courses for the legal professions in France or abroad.\*

\*with the exception of Germany, because of the specificities of access to the legal profession in that country.

## 5) IRELAND

### University College Dublin



In the framework of the Bilingual Bachelor's Degree in French Law and Common Law, students can opt for a Double Degree programme with University College Dublin in their 3rd year. They spend two years in UCD, at the end of which they are awarded a Bachelor's Degree in Law from the University of Toulouse Capitole, a Bachelor's Degree in Civil Law (equivalent to the UK LLB) from UCD and they obtain the first year of the French Master's Degree (M1) by equivalence.

The selection is made on the basis of the application file compiled via the Parcoursup platform. It may be supplemented by an interview.

■ Applications via the Parcoursup platform is required for:

· holders or future holders of the French baccalaureate or an equivalent diploma from the European Union, the European Economic Area and the Swiss Confederation

· nationals of an EU member state.
